CONSENT ORDER

**IN THE MATTER OF:
JEFFERY P. RAHMAN
RESPIRATORY CARE LICENSE #3506**

WHEREAS the North Carolina Respiratory Care Board (the "Board") is charged with the administration of The Respiratory Care Practice Act, codified in the North Carolina General Statutes at G.S. 90-646 et Seq. (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS the Licensee was found allowing an unlicensed individual, under his supervision, to practice Respiratory Care in North Carolina in violation of G.S. 90.659(a)(4)c and G.S. 90.661(4); and

WHEREAS the Board conducted an investigation pursuant to G.S. 90-652 (5) into the activities of Licensee to determine if he has violated, is violating, or is about to violate any provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS the RCP license of Michael Philippeaux expired at midnight on January 2, 2005; and

WHEREAS the Licensee allowed Michael Philippeaux, RCP # 3643, to work with an expired license between the dates 1/2/05 to 1/14/05; and

WHEREAS Board policy authorizes the Executive Director to offer the option of a Reprimand to a licensee practicing respiratory care with a lapsed license or to a licensee employing a person with a lapsed license; and

WHEREAS Licensee agrees to the entry of this Consent Order, and voluntarily agrees to waive any rights to a hearing upon entry of this Consent Order, and waives the right to seek judicial review or otherwise challenge or contest the validity of this Consent Order;

AND WHEREAS upon the entry of this Consent Order, this matter will be resolved with the express understanding that Licensee will comply with all of the terms contained herein.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Jeffery P. Rahman shall continue to comply with the Act, the Board's Rules, and the Board's interpretation of those rules.

Jeffery P. Rahman agrees to the issuance of a Board Reprimand for his violations of the Act.

Jeffery P. Rahman agrees to pay to the Board within 90 days from the date of signature of the consent order, the sum of \$250.00 for Civil Penalties which are authorized by G.S. 90-666(a) and 21 NCAC 61.0309 (d)(1) and the sum of \$50.00 to pay the cost of disciplinary action as authorized by G.S. 90-666(d).

Entry of this Consent Order by the Board is without prejudice to the right of the Board to take any administrative action against Jeffery P. Rahman to enforce this Consent Order if the Board determines that Jeffery P. Rahman is not fully complying with any term or condition stated herein;

Entry of this Consent Order by the Board does not preclude the Board from taking other adverse action against Jeffery P. Rahman for other acts or omissions by Jeffery P. Rahman that may be brought to Board's attention in the future; and

This Consent Order shall become final when accepted by Jeffery P. Rahman and entered by the Board based on the execution by its Executive Director.


