CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF: SHAWN DAHLQUIST LAPSED PROVISIONAL RESPIRATORY CARE LICENSE #396

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WHEREAS the North Carolina Respiratory Care Board (the "Board") is charged with the administration of The Respiratory Care Practice Act, codified in the North Carolina General Statutes at G.S. 90-646 et Seq. (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS the Licensee was found practicing Respiratory Care in North Carolina with a Lapsed Provisional Respiratory Care Practitioner license in violation of G.S. 90.659(a)(1) c and G.S. 90.661(1)(2)(3) and (4), and

WHEREAS the Board conducted an investigation pursuant to G.S. 90-652 (5) into the activities of Licensee to determine if he has violated, is violating, or is about to violate any provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS at midnight on March 11, 2003 the Provisional license issued to the Licensee expired, and

WHEREAS the Board staff on April 17, 2003, found the Licensee practicing Respiratory Care with a lapsed Provisional license by telephone interviews with the licensee and the licensee's supervisors at Alamance Regional Medical Center, Burlington, North Carolina, and

WHEREAS Board policy authorizes the Executive Director to issue a Reprimand to individuals found practicing Respiratory Care with a lapsed license within one (1) year of the expiration date of the license, and

WHEREAS Licensee agrees to the entry of this Consent Order, and voluntarily agrees to waive any rights to a hearing upon entry of this Consent Order, and waives the right to seek judicial review or otherwise challenge or contest the validity of this Consent Order

AND WHEREAS upon the entry of this Consent Order, this matter will be resolved and the Board will issue Licensee a license, with the express understanding that Licensee will comply with all of the terms contained herein.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Licensee shall continue to comply with the Act, the Board's Rules, and the Board's interpretation of those rules.

Licensee agrees to the issuance of a Board Reprimand for his violations of the Act.

Entry of this Consent Order by the Board is without prejudice to the right of the Board to take any administrative action against Licensee to enforce this Consent Order if the Board determines that Licensee is not fully complying with any term or condition stated herein; and,

This Consent Order shall become final when accepted by the Licensee and entered by the Board based on the execution by its Executive Director.
